

ORDINANCE CM-12-09

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE UPDATE AND SUPPLEMENTAL PAGES TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST MILTON CODE OF ORDINANCES AND TO INCLUDE DULY ADOPTED ORDINANCES OF COUNCIL NOT PREVIOUSLY CODIFIED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Municipality periodically updates its Code of Ordinances to assure that newly enacted and amended ordinances are properly codified in form and substance so as to promote the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Municipality and for the proper conduct of its business and operations, and;

WHEREAS, the Municipality's 2012 budget includes an appropriation for an update to the Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide for the uninterrupted conduct of business and other operations of the Municipality necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the community, it is necessary for this ordinance to take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.

NOW THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Council of the Municipality of West Milton, Ohio, that:

SECTION I: The Municipal Manager is hereby authorized to order the supplemental and additional pages to include legislation from October 2004 to December 2011 from American Legal Publishing of Cincinnati, Ohio at a price not to exceed \$7,000.00.

SECTION II: Such additional code pages shall be deemed published at the date of its adoption and approval by Council and a copy shall be filed in the Office of the Clerk.

SECTION III: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective upon its passage.
