

RESOLUTION CM-16-37

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF AN ELECTRIC POWER AGGREGATION PLAN OF OPERATION AND GOVERNANCE FOR THE VILLAGE OF WEST MILTON, MIAMI COUNTY, OHIO

WHEREAS, the electorate of West Milton, Ohio has previously authorized the Village to aggregate eligible retail electric loads located within the governmental boundaries of the Village of West Milton and to enter into service agreements for the sale and purchase of electricity, such aggregation to occur automatically except where any person elects to opt out, in accordance with ORC 4928.20; and

WHEREAS, the Village has executed an agreement with Supernova Partners, LLC, Affordable Gas & Electric Company, LLC to provide consulting services to assist with the development and implementation of an electric power aggregation program; and

WHEREAS, the Village has held two public hearings on the Plan of Operation and Governance in accordance with ORC 4928.20(C).

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the Municipality of West Milton, Ohio that:

SECTION I: The Village Council of West Milton hereby adopts an Electric Power Aggregation Plan of Operation and Governance for The Village of West Milton pursuant to PUCO regulations.

SECTION II: A copy of said Plan is hereby attached and marked as "Exhibit A" and is made part of this resolution.

SECTION III: This Resolution will adopt The Village of West Milton's Electric Power Aggregation Plan of Operation and Governance for the West Milton electric aggregation program to allow eligible residents to reduce their electric bill as quickly as possible, provided the resolution receives the affirmative vote of the majority of members elected to the Village Council, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest time allowed by law.
